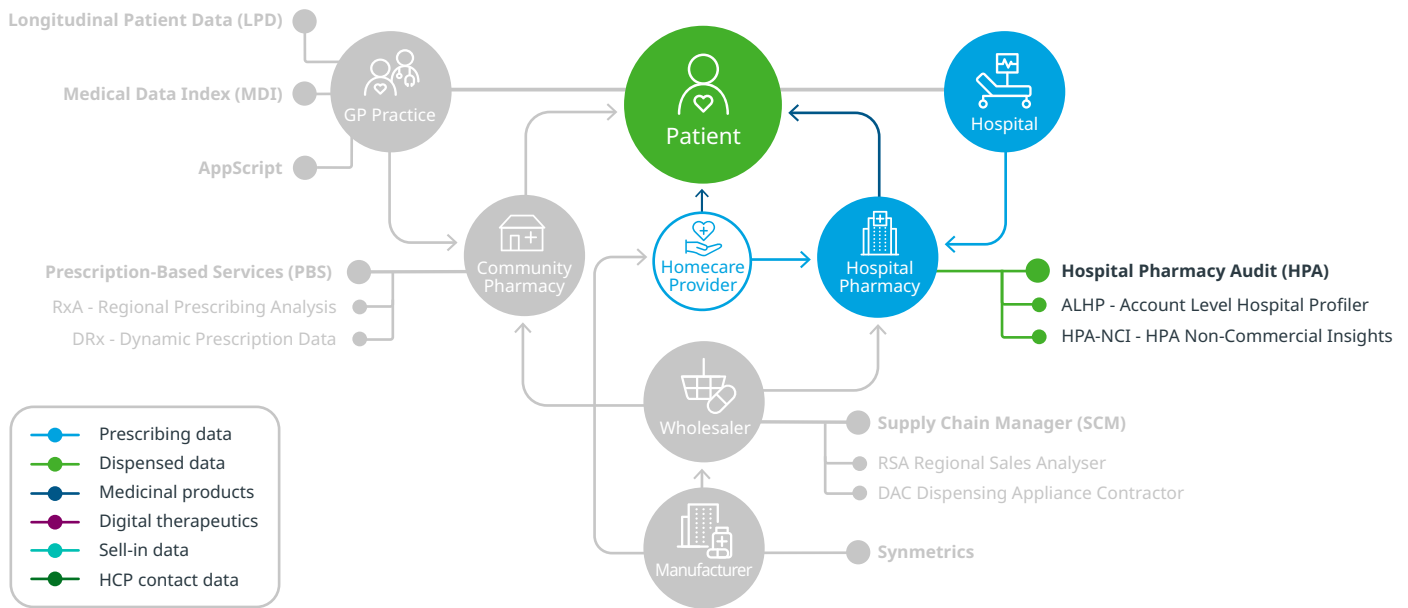

What is Hospital Pharmacy Audit?

- Available at a national and sub-national level reporting down to departments and specialties
- It allows you to see usage for in-patient, out-patient and homecare transactions, and monitor dispensing levels by the end user
- Data is projected at a national level to account for off-panel sites
- Includes private and community dispensing through NHS hospital pharmacies

TYPES OF HOSPITAL PHARMACY AUDIT REPORTS

Reports can be produced in online report, ADaM or XML format for the following offerings:

- **National trawling** — all products at a national level down to pack granularity
- **National overview** — all products at a national level down to product granularity
- **National indepth** — bespoke market at a national level to product or pack granularity
- **Subnational** — bespoke market at hospital and brick level, to product or pack granularity
- **Combined Prescription Based Services and Hospital Pharmacy Audit** reports — trawling/overview/indepth reports at a national level, combined with retail pharmacy and internet pharmacy data
