DESCRIPTION OF LIST AND SOURCE NAMES: OneKey is a database of healthcare professionals at healthcare sites. The proprietary database from IQVIA is compiled and updated continuously through web research, customer inquiries and change requests, IQVIA transactional data, and trusted industry and government sources. The OneKey database supports sales, marketing, research and compliance initiatives for life sciences, medical equipment and device companies, healthcare IT providers, managed care, direct marketing, publishing, government, insurance, education, pharmacies, food services and other stakeholders.

LIST TOTAL: List total as of February 2024 is 2,111,403.

PURPOSE: The data reported herein is an analysis of the business/function.

METHOD OF CONFIRMATION: Demographic information as reported herein, including name, title/function, and address were confirmed by AAM through the following procedures: A sample was drawn by audit personnel using a random starting point and an interval selection thereafter. For the selection,

a. A test verification was conducted to verify accuracy of the list sources.

DUPLICATION: The level of healthcare professionals at multiple locations in the database was found to be 58.1% or 1,227,047 users.

Verification Mailing:

In addition to the examination of the physical records maintained by the list owner, to verify the data reported in section Business/Occupational Analysis, Mailing Analysis, and the Geographical Analysis, a verification test was conducted on a randomly selected sample of 100 names for deliverability.
